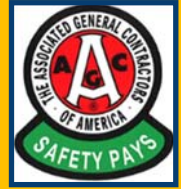

“The Business Side of Safety”

This course is specifically designed on how safety influences your company’s bottom line through the experience modification rating (EMR) and workers compensation. The EMR has not only become an adjustment to your worker’s compensation premium, but has also become a strong indicator of the success of your safety program. Consequently, more General Contractors and Owners are using this rating as a pre-qualification factor. Contractors that find themselves above 1 will undoubtedly lose opportunities for work. Specifically, this course will discuss in depth the Experience Modification Rating (EMR). Topics of discussion will include:

- How Losses are defined?
- How the real cost of an accident factors into profits and Losses?
- What is the EMR Rate, how it is calculated and how it effects your organization?
- Strategies to manage your risk exposure and get your EMR lower.

PRESENTER: Mr. Bartholomew is the President of CORE Safety Group. He is a graduate from Indiana State University with a Bachelors of Science in Construction Management and Safety Management. Mr. Bartholomew has over 20 years of experience in construction safety and currently holds his designation as a Certified Safety Professional (CSP) and Construction Health and Safety Technician (CHST) and Occupational Hygiene and Safety Technician (OHST).

Educational Program: Safety Culture with Lean Management Tools

The construction industry has been employing lean principles primarily in field production through Last Planner and Pull Scheduling. Other lean tools are being used to improve contract relationships and improving jobsite coordination. Lean principles can extend further to improve safety and quality of the work performed. This seminar will discuss lean philosophy and the elimination of waste to improve the construction process, especially in the realm of accident elimination. Attendees will learn how to utilize lean tools and a lean attitude to enhance their company’s safety culture and improve safety performance.

PRESENTER Mark Rounds: Vice President of Corporation Development for Vogel Brothers Building Co. In his role, he is responsible for coaching personnel and optimizing systems to improve the overall performance of the organization. He has over 35 years of experience in the construction industry holding positions as laborer, superintendent, project engineer, estimator, senior project manager, and vice president of operations. He is an adjunct professor at the University of Wisconsin Madison and at the Milwaukee School of Engineering, teaching classes in leadership and professional development.
